Budget and Finance/Strategic Planning

Preparation of the Association's annual budget for submission to the Board of Directors. Reviews membership changes as they relate to income. Monitors and maintains the Association's investments. Reviews the performance of the budget throughout the year. Meet monthly.

Bylaws

Reviews the bylaws, rules and regulations and other governing documents of enforcement to determine if they are in the best interest of Membership, and are in compliance with applicable law. Meet as needed.

Education/Membership

Promotes to members and non-members the benefits of membership in the Association of Realtors®. Prepares monthly membership meetings, including speakers. Implements and maintains ongoing programs designed to develop and enhance member's leadership skills to better prepare them for future leadership roles in the Association.
